General Information

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The 2011 Zone 2 Skeet Championship is open to all NSSA members in good standing. **NSSA rules govern this shoot.**
2. Classes AAA, AA, A, B, C, D, and E for 12 Gauge, HOA, and HAA Events. Classes AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D only for all other events.
3. Medals for Events #1 through 8 awarded to Pennsylvania residents only for Champion, Runner-up, and Third; Class 1st through 5th, except AAA and AA which are Class 1st and 2nd only, Concurrent 1st and 2nd for Events #1 to 6, except Lady, Junior, and Sub Junior which include 3rd Place. Medals must be picked up after event, they will not be mailed.
4. Two Man and Five Man Teams open to Zone 2 residents only, NSSA Rules defining teams apply. Two Man and Five Man Teams must be shot shoulder to shoulder.
5. Shooting order: Preliminary (.410), Doubles, 20, 12, 28, .410
6. Practice fields will be available starting Thursday August 11th. Starting Friday August 12th practice will be limited to Fields #15 & 16 unless needed by participants in the shoot.
7. Shooting Referees will be allowed and welcome.

Shoot Management reserves the right without protest to change or suspend this program without notice. Management reserves the right without protest to refuse entry or cause the withdrawal of any shooter for any reason Management deems appropriate.

Reservation and Squadding Information

1. All advance reservation information will be done by mail, absolutely no phone calls or e-mail. Reservation forms will be handled by date of postmark.
2. Shooter reservations for four guns will be given preference for Rotation assignment. Shooters reserving for less than four guns will be scheduled as near as possible to their requested times but by necessity will be accommodated according to space availability and the discretion of shoot management.
3. Five person squads or any shooters wishing to shoot together must reserve together on the same reservation form and with all deposits in the same single mailing. Please include your desired shooting order.
4. Reservation forms must be accompanied by a \$50 deposit for each shooter listed. Deposits are refundable for cancellations **received by July 20th**. After that date there are no refunds.

Registration Information

1. Registration opens beginning Thursday, August 11th in mid-afternoon until 5:00pm, and will be open daily until start of the last flight each day thereafter.
2. At registration shooters must have their 2011 Classification Card, with individual gun classification and averages up to date.
3. Registration, including changes, must be completed one hour prior to the event. Squads registering late may be broken up for best field utilization.
4. Non-classified shooters must declare AA class in order to play optional class purse.
5. **No refunds in case of withdrawal and fees are not transferable. Deposits are not transferable.**
6. All purse pay-outs are rounded to the nearest dollar and payment made by check which will be mailed at the conclusion of the shoot.
7. Shooting order established according to registration forms and not subject to change once established.
8. HOA class cannot be lower than shooter's lowest gun class.
9. Concurrents will be shot off concurrently with other events, where possible.
10. Shooters limited to one entry in each team category.
11. All payments will be by cash or check, no credit, debit, or check cards accepted.
12. Make checks payable to Shenecoy Sportsmen.
13. All Registration Fees include NSSA and PSSA target fees.

Rules on the Fields

1. All score sheets must be checked and signed by a squad member before leaving the field. Scores will be posted as soon as possible after each flight is finished shooting. All shooters are responsible for verifying the posted class, scores, and options.
2. Scores and all results become official one-half hour after final posting. It is the shooters responsibility to verify correct scores, proper class, options, etc. and notify shoot management immediately if incorrect.
3. SQUADS WILL NOT BE CALLED. Shooters not ready on the field at their designated time will be dropped off entry without refund. Upon request such shooters may be re-squadded at a later time if space is available.
4. Proof shells not provided, shooters must provide their own shells.
5. All protests must be processed in accordance with NSSA rules and will be ruled upon by the Protest Committee.
6. Shooters and spectators assume all risks of loss or injury while on Club grounds.
7. Only designated target loaders or mechanics are allowed in skeet houses, even referees may not adjust machines.
8. Shooting of hats will only be done on Field 3 after all scheduled events of the day have concluded and under the supervision of a field referee.
9. No vehicles or dogs allowed on shooting fields.
10. No alcoholic beverages may be consumed until the shooter has completed shooting for that day.

Shoot-Off Information

Shoot-off procedures have been developed to eliminate confusion and streamline the efforts of the shooters and referees. Please read the following closely:

1. Shoot-offs will be held for:
 - > Champion, Runner-up, Third, and Class 1st and 2nd in all events
 - > Concurrent Champion in all events including Team events
 - > Team event shoot-off must be shot shoulder to shoulder, Team score determined by station
 - > HOA Handicap
 - > Where possible, Class and Concurrents will be done concurrently
2. All other ties broken by long run, front, high gun. Champ of Champs, Oklahoma 50's, and Lewis Class ties divide.
3. All money ties divide.
4. Shooters must report to the Shoot-Off Fields 2, 3, & 4 with (2) boxes of shells. No proof shells provided.
5. The Goal is to have the last shooter standing be the Gun Champion on Field #3 providing the Champion proper recognition.
6. Shoot-offs will be Doubles on Stations 3, 4, 5, 4, 3, miss and out by station. If necessary, all orange targets will be used under the lights.
7. Shoot-offs will be posted on the Shoot-Off Board outside the Registration Building after the conclusion of the last flight of an event. It is the shooter's responsibility to check the Main Scoreboard to see if you have tied with another shooter and/or check the Shoot-Off Board to see if you are in a shoot-off.
8. Listen to the announcement of the field assignment for your shoot-off and proceed immediately to that field.
9. After shooter is released from the shoot-off field, remain in the shoot-off area and listen for re-assignment for additional or continuation of a shoot-off.
10. Champion, Runner-up, and Third in events will receive their Medal immediately after that shoot-off is completed at a presentation with photographs on the field. All other medals can be claimed at the canopied table opposite the Registration Building.
11. Only shooters are allowed beyond roped off Shoot-Off area.
12. Referees will be assigned to all Shoot-off fields.
