**In addition to the payout to the Gun Champ, Runner Up, & 3<sup>rd</sup> Place finishers;**

**Of the \$65/100 fee, \$10 shall go back to the Shooters. \$1.33 to Champion, \$1.00 to Runner-Up, & \$0.67 to 3rd Place. The Remaining \$7 will go back to class. 3rd Place finisher award shall be at minimum >\$10 than the highest-Class Purse winner.**

**Class payout shall be:**

**1-10 100%**

**11-20 60/40**

**21-30 50/30/20**

**31-40 40/30/20/10**

**41 + 35/25/15/10/8/7**

**Juniors and Sub-Juniors Gun Entry fee shall be \$35 per 100 targets**

The PSSA shall provide a \$20 per 100 targets Scholarship for Jr and Sub-Jr Shooters. However, the Scholarship funded shooters shall participate for Honors, Concurrent Awards, and Medals. As per NSSA rules they are ineligible to participate in any optional cash purses.

Youth shooters may shoot for all cash purses if they forego the PSSA 'scholarship' and pay the full entry fee for the shoot.

## **PSSA SPECIAL EVENTS & OPTIONS**







1. **LEWIS CLASS:** Cost \$5 per gun. Ties divide. Two classes in Events 1, Three classes in Events 2-5.
2. **Optional Class Purse:** \$10 per Gun, HOA, and HAA  
**ALL MONEY PAY-OUT CHART:**
  - 1 to 6 entries 100%
  - 7 to 15 entries 60/40%
  - 16 to 25 entries 50/30/20%
  - 26 and Over 40/30/20/10%
3. **Oklahoma OPTIONS ON 50's:**  
Entry Fee: \$15 each event; \$5 of each entry placed on each of the 50s within an event; by class  
Rounds 1&2 make up first 50; rounds 2&3 make up middle 50; rounds 3&4 make up last 50.  
Option is offered in all events except HOA/HAA.  
Payout: High Gun; (Top scores split).
4. **Champ of Champs** - \$10 per gun - The combined scores of the last box of each gauge; ties divide, no shootoffs.
5. **B, C, D, E Handicap Option** - 12 gauge ONLY – Cost \$10 - **No Shootoffs**
  - a. Option is **AVAILABLE to Only 12 gauge shooters with an established NSSA** B, C, D, or E class average may enter.
  - b. Each class shooter shall be provided a Handicap number of targets.
  - c. Every shooter who shoots a maximum score of 100 by adding their 12-gauge score + the Handicap target allowance shall divide the purse. 100 shall be the max score possible.
    - i. B Class Handicap = 3 targets
    - ii. C Class Handicap = 6 targets
    - iii. D Class Handicap = 9 targets
    - iv. E Class Handicap = 14 targets
6. **HOA** – \$10 to participate in the optional **HOA Purse**. All HOA purse money paid out shall be to the shooters who played the HOA Optional Purse.  
All Shooters, PA resident and Non-residents, who complete four guns shall compete for HOA All American Points.  
All Pennsylvania State shooters who complete four-guns shall be eligible to compete for the PA State HOA **Honors & PA State Medals**, whether or not they played the HOA Optional Purse.
7. **HAA** – is a **Honors and PA State Medals** Only event.
8. **Alyssa Gormish HOA Lady:** Must shoot all four main guns to be eligible.
9. **PRIZE MEDALS OPTIONS - (Pennsylvania Residents Only)**  
**Neck Medallions for Gun Champ, Runner Up, & 3<sup>rd</sup> Place**  
Junior and Sub Junior Medals in doubles to 8 places  
Junior and Sub Junior Medals in 12 and 20 gauges to 10 places  
Junior and Sub Junior Medals in 28 gauge, .410 Bore, HOA and HAA to 8 places  
**Medals shall be mailed out to Winners after the event.**
10. **Site Specific Options** may be offered at the discretion of the Host clubs. Please inquire with the host clubs if they plan to offer other club exclusive options to their site. Host sites may host their own special events outside the management of the PA State Championships. These special events are managed entirely by the host club and will be posted at registration at the Host Club. The Host Clubs shall handle payment of the club's exclusive options after the completion of the event.

**ALL ENTRANTS** must be current members of NSSA. Membership forms will be available.

**SHOOT MANAGER:** Tami Daniel-Means

**CAMPERS/RV's:** For Camper/RV availability and rental fees please check with the Host Club you are registered at.

**KITCHEN:** Food shall be provided at each location. Please check with the Host Club for the particulars of food availability.

**PROGRAM CHANGES** - Any part of this shoot program may be changed by Shoot Management. Notices of any change(s) will be posted in Registration. It is the shooter's responsibility to become aware of any change.

**GENERAL INFORMATION** - This shoot is a registered tournament and NSSA rules will govern.

Contestants will not be allowed in the trap houses except by permission of the shoot management.

Reload shells will be permitted, subject to inspection. Factory-new shells may be available at standard club prices (limited supply). Please, check ahead with your Host Club to verify the supply of ammunition if needed.

Squads will not be called. It is the shooter's responsibility to be at the correct field on time. Shooters missing their scheduled squad time run the risk of not completing the event. Shooters missing their squad will be allowed to join their squad in a subsequent round and finish the event by his or herself provided, in the opinion of the chief referee, there is sufficient time before the next flight. If there is not time, they will be moved to the last flight of the day.

**PROTEST COMMITTEE:** All protests must be presented to the Protest Committee within thirty minutes after the flight is finished. The Protest Committee will be posted during the shoot.

**LIABILITY** - Participants and spectators recognize the exposure to potential injury associated with shotgun sports and assume all risks of accidents while attending this tournament.

**REFEREES** - This tournament will provide professional referees. Calls made by the referee will stand unless they are overruled by the Protest Committee.

**SHOOT-OFFS** - Open and State; Champion, Runner-up, Third place, Open Classes 1<sup>st</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> and Concurrent Titles. Winners will be determined by doubles on stations 3, 4 and 5.- Shooter shall furnish their shoot-off shells and proofs.

Shoot-offs shall be conducted doubles stations 3-4-5, miss-and-out by station. This means that a shooter must break both targets on a station in order to beat a shooter who only broke one target (i.e. if one shooter breaks the first target and another shooter breaks the second target, they are still tied) as described in the current NSSA rule-book.

Each Shoot-Off long-run is the number of targets broken from the front before a miss, by station. After a miss on any station the next long-run restarts on the next station.

When a shooter is tied for multiple awards there will only be one shoot-off, and all shoot-off long-runs shall be posted as soon as possible at: <https://iskeet.org/iskeet/> so determination of any shoot-off long-run ties that exist between all sites and the best opportunity to break those ties. **Host clubs must immediately upload pdf or image format scans of all shoot-off sheets, as they are entered, for the Overall event administrator to validate entry of shoot-off long-runs.**

All shooters shooting scores of 100 or 99 in an event should expect to shoot-off for the entire event. For the first event of the day, the Site and Overall event shoot-offs will be posted as soon as possible. Host club administration can and should support the effort by breaking any ties at their clubs as they would do at any other event. This is especially true for the second events of any day, and for the 410 Bore and HOA on the closing day. In this way shoot-off long-runs are available to all admins if needed to break a ties across the entire event and does not require the shooter finishing early to wait unless they wish to do so.

***1. Shoot-offs for each event will be scheduled by each host club following the completion of that event at that club and when fields become available. Host clubs having available fields should proactively schedule those fields to be used for shoot-offs especially on the final day of events to afford shooters the ability to shoot-off before the end of the day. All shoot off targets are reimbursed to the clubs at approximate cost. Therefore, if there is the possibility a shootoff may be required, the club Admin shall proactively insist the shooters record a Shootoff Score.***

2. Finalized shoot-off details in the master program posted at <https://iskeet.org> will be used by all clubs to ensure shoot-offs are conducted following the same procedures.
3. Shooters who are involved in shoot-offs should report to the shoot-off field(s) as scheduled at their host club with two boxes of shells and proof shells.
4. For the first round to determine the overall event and site-specific awards, shooters will shoot doubles on 3-4-5, NSSA rules, until they complete round one straight, 2 misses or voluntarily stop shooting. Host clubs will immediately post these long-runs online to break long-run ties between other sites. Host clubs should move shooters to a continuation sheet and **immediately upload pdf or image format scans** of all round one shoot-off sheets, as long-runs are entered, to the Overall event administrator to validate entry of shoot-off long-runs.
5. If multiple shooters at the same site are straight after round one, they should continue into the second round until a shooter completes round two having only one (1) lost target. Host clubs will immediately post these long runs online to break long-run ties between other sites and immediately upload pdf or image format scans of all round one shoot-off sheets, as long-runs are entered, to the Overall event administrator to validate entry of shoot-off long-runs.
6. For sites that have Shooters who have not missed in the first two rounds should contact the shoot-off administrator before starting the third round and upon completion the third round having only one (1) lost target. Host clubs should immediately post these long-runs online to determine long-run ties between other sites and determine if the shooter should continue. Host clubs should immediately upload pdf or image format scans of all shoot-off sheets, as long-runs are entered, to the Overall event administrator to validate entry of shoot-off long-runs.
7. All Host club management will coordinate with the overall event management at the end of all rounds to determine if shooters who are still straight or down one (1) target at the end of a round should continue to shoot.
8. Host clubs will immediately submit pdf or image format scans of all shoot off sheets as the long-runs are entered to the Overall event administrator to validate entry of shoot-off long-runs.
9. Host clubs should complete and coordinate any additional site shoot-offs required to facilitate the use of those scores if needed by a later for later shoot-offs.
10. In the Overall event, any ties of less than perfect scores where ALL the shooters involved have not been posted as No-Show or have a long-run score, will be broken by long-run.
11. Any shoot-offs of less than perfect scores that are missed or not otherwise broken will be broken by long-run.
12. Any shoot-off long-run ties that are missed or not otherwise broken will be broken by coin flip.
13. Shooters will be afforded a 10 minute break between the 2nd and 3rd rounds as well as the 4th and 5th rounds.
14. The NSSA shoot admin will determine all additional shoot-offs that are required after all scores for the event have been posted and will notify the respective clubs to print off their shoot-off sheets for their location and have shooters shoot off.
15. Clubs should always post shoot-off long-runs at: <https://iskeet.org/iskeet/> as soon as possible to determine any shoot-off long-run ties that exist and the best opportunity to break those ties. Host clubs should immediately upload pdf or image format scans of all shoot-off sheets, as long-runs are entered, to the Overall event administrator to validate entry of shoot-off long-runs.
16. To expedite shoot-offs and avoid shooters having to shoot solo, Host clubs should combine shoot-offs by round where possible. The use of pacing shooters is otherwise NOT permitted.
